Injured: 6 March 1943 by navy auto in Oran, Algeria.

Admitted: 6 March 1943 - direct admission.

Died: 6 March 1943 - in severe traumatic shock.

This elderly man was struck by auto in Oran in same accident as preceding case (M.P.) sustaining multiple severe injuries, fracture dislocation of left shoulder, puncture wound of left lung, with extensive subcutaneous emphysema, compound fracture of left tibia, fracture dislocation of left hip and probable skull fracture. He was taken at once to ward # 22 where plasma was started and temporary splinting applied. He died in shock about 1½ hours after admission.

No post mortem was performed.

Clinical diagnoses: Fracture dislocation of left shoulder. Puncture wound of left lung with extensive emphysema. Compound fracture of left tibia. Fracture dislocation left hip. Probable skull fracture.
