Gentlemen,

It is my duty to inform you, that, at a meeting of the Faculty of the Jefferson Medical College of Philadelphia held this day, Professors Grossard and Rand were appointed "Delegates" to the next meeting at Washington.

At the same meeting, it was resolved, that whenever a majority of the prominent schools of the country give their assent to the proposed changes in the Curriculum, the Jefferson Medical College will, with the permission of the Board of Trustees, heartily cooperate.
