<sup>d</sup>There are too few cases of rape/sexual assault in the sample of males with SMI to report incidence rates, incidence ratios or tests by race/ethnicity.

<sup>e</sup>Because the Taylor series linearization refers to the t distribution to calculate confidence bounds, the lower computed confidence bound of the incidence ratio among persons with SMI may be below zero.
