

MuSIC – Multiple Sequence Iterative Comparator

Installing for the first time

1. If you do not already have the Java runtime libraries installed, get them from <https://www.java.com/en/download/manual.jsp>.
2. If you are running Windows, copy the MuSIC-J.exe to a location on your computer (such as the Documents folder).
3. If you are on a Mac/Linux, etc... download the MuSIC-J.jar file instead.
4. If you are running MuSIC for the first time (on that machine) you will be prompted to specify the locations of the Ladders, Primers, and Features database files. If you have those files from a previous installation, locate them in the file explorer window and drag them to the appropriate text box then click the confirmation button.

Updating from a different version

1. Copy the MuSIC-J.exe (If you are running Windows or the MuSIC-J.jar file if on another operating system) to the location of the current version of MuSIC on your computer and confirm to overwrite.
