Injured: 14 Feb. 1943 - on road at Oran, Algeria.  
Admitted: 14 Feb. 1943 - direct admission.  
Died: 14 Feb. 1943 - of shock attributed to his injury.

This patient was brought directly to the A&D office from scene of automobile accident near gap on sea road to Oran. He was seen at once by Maj. Droegemueller (SOD), Majors Greene and Walsh. He was bleeding furiously from a severe laceration over the sacrum and was in marked shock. He was sent to ward # 8 after emergency dressing was applied and morphine administered. Attempts to give intravenous and intrasternal fluids failed. The patient died within a few hours of admission of shock.

No post mortem was performed.

Diagnoses: Wound, severe penetrating back. Fracture compound, comminuted sacrum and ileum. Shock, traumatic, severe.
