SSS. J.D.

Injured: 15 Aug. 1943 in an automobile accident near Ain-el-turck, Algeria. (same accident as J.Z.)

Admitted: 15 Aug. 1943 - direct.

Died: 15 Aug. 1943 - from hemorrhagic and traumatic shock as result of his injuries.

This soldier (age ?) was pulseless, in profound shock and dyspheic from an evident chest and cardiac wound. All efforts at resuscitation failed and he died within 15 minutes of the time he was deposited in the operating room.

Autopsy revealed alcoholic odor to gastric contents. There was a crushing injury to the chest with severe contusion of heart, lungs, a ruptured spleen with extensive hemorrhage, subpial hemorrhages and cerebral edema thought due to alcohol.
